Concentration Camp

The former concentration camp (1933 - 1945) is now officially known as the Dachau Concentration Camp Memorial Site (1965).

This is the best maintained camp and therefore well worth the trip.

Site admission is free and visitor services include:

- a 22 minute documentary film
(10:00 a.m.; 11:30 a.m.; 12:30 p.m.; 2:00 p.m. & 3:00 p.m.),
- access to the grounds & memorials, as well as
- comprehensive exhibitions & museum.

Audio guides are available for 3,50€/2,50€ for students and includes an informative map of the area. Highly recommended.

&/or the on-site 2.5 hours tour available for 3€ (11:00 a.m. & 1:00 p.m.)

Note: Registration is at the information desk of the Visitors' Center.

Buy your tickets at least 15 minutes in advance (Max.: 30 people)

DIRECTIONS (00:38 minutes travel time)

- ~ Go to **Hauptbahnhof** and follow the 'S' Bahn signs
- ~ Take the **S2** (Altomünster) train :10, :30 & :50 past the hour
- ~ Exit the train at the **Dachau** station (21 mins.)
- ~ Follow the crowd to the bus stop
- ~ Take **Bus #726** (Gewerbegebiet Ost ü. KZ-Gedenkstätte)
- ~ Exit bus at the **Dachau/KZ-Gedenkstätte** bus stop (7 mins)
- ~ Follow the crowd to the Memorial Site Entrance

OPENING HOURS

The Memorial Site is Open **DAILY** from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
The Memorial Site is Closed only on 24th December annually.

TRANSPORTATION

Tageskarte/Day Ticket:

1 person ~ Tariff zone "M-1" Single-Tageskarte = 8,90€

2-5 people ~ Tariff zone "M-1" Partner-Tageskarte = 16,10€

NB: After time stamp validation of your Tageskarte, it is **valid until 6 a.m.** on all Busses, Trams, S-Bahn & U-Bahn Trains in the Munich "M-1" zone.
